Our permitting process is going on pretty much as scheduled. We're hoping to have the new document in hand by the end of March or early April. It is a rather large coordination effort between the towns of Bellingham and Blackstone, Aquatic Technology Control and the LHA. But, little by little, we are getting there!

We have also begun the first step towards refurbishing the boat access ramp at the end of Marcel Lane. Initially, we need to get an accurate survey of the area, which we have contracted to do.
